Missouri Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT) FACT SHEET

Here is some good news you didn't know about!

- 28,400 Missouri children and their families still have \$13.5 million in unclaimed Pandemic food benefits¹. At least \$391 (per eligible child) is waiting for them to spend on free groceries.
- Most families have six weeks left to start spending. If families do not start spending, the money will be all gone by June 30.
- \$27.3 million in P-EBT has already been expunged from eligible card holders over the past five months. These dollars are gone. But \$13.5 million remains active and unclaimed; free grocery dollars are still available for families to spend.



- 7,625 of the unclaimed P-EBT cards are in the group of SNAP eligible under age six children in child care. The average amount of unclaimed P-EBT dollars is \$713 per card holder.
- Solution: P-EBT is for families struggling to make ends meet. What's missing is publicity. If families don't know about the unclaimed P-EBT money, they won't have a chance to spend.
